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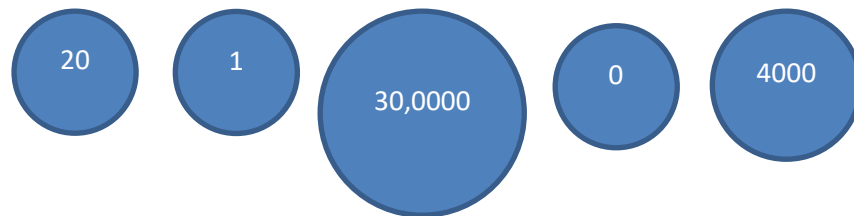
PLACE VALUE BUBBLES

(Or: TT, Th, H, T, O) as we did in class.

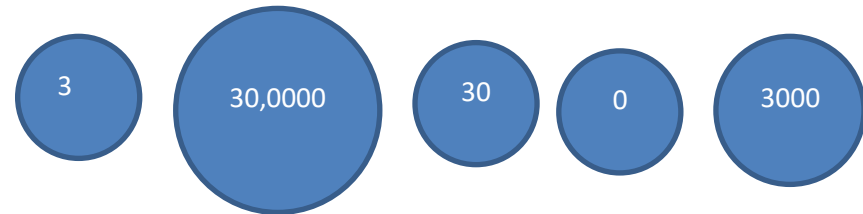
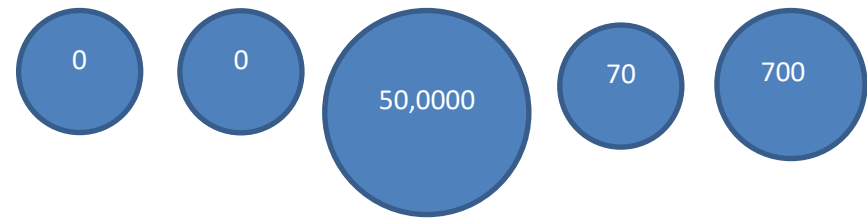
Place these number bubbles in the right order from highest number value to lowest and create the correct number.

When the bubble has a "0" in it! Fill all the row here with "0".

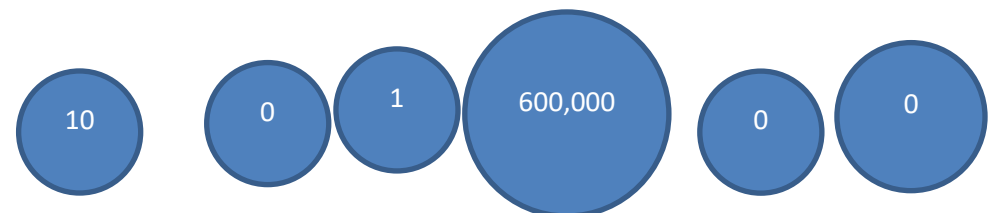
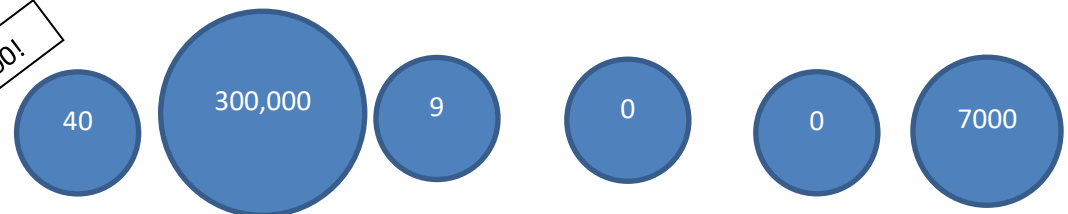
