Our whole school Arts performance, *Melted – a Musical*, is coming up very soon and here is some important information for everyone.

Every student from K-6 is in the show, either onstage or backstage, for both shows. It is a wonderful opportunity to showcase what all of the school has been doing within the Arts area of our curriculum. The entire staff is also participating integrally. All of our Arts groups have been working excitedly to pull together their item/s to help tell the story of this musical which is a bit like *Frozen*, but the opposite.

The date: Week 9, Thursday, 14th September
Shows: 3pm and 5.30pm

Tickets are \$5 per seat and any babies/toddlers who can sit on a lap are free.

Students of St Cecilia's will not need to have a ticket purchased as they will be sitting in seats.

All of Kindergarten and Pre Primary will get to watch both shows from special mats in front of the stage, so you do not need to collect them after school, only take them home after the last show finishes. They are in both runs of the show.

We have a 3pm show seating 246 then the same at 5.30pm. You are welcome to buy tickets for yourself and any friends/family who may wish to come.

ON THE DAY:

This will be a long day for all of our students, so a good night's sleep the night before might be a great idea. The day of the musical will be structured as follows:

- 8.40am: Full final dress rehearsal until recess.**
- 10.20am: Recess**
- 10.50am: After recess – lunch: light classroom activities/optional rest time for students determined by staff.**
- 12.20pm: Lunch**
- 1.00pm: Students to begin preparing for the performances.**

- Each show will go for approximately 80 minutes.
- Between the 3pm show and the 5.30pm show, our students will REMAIN AT SCHOOL with full staff supervision. We will share some ideas of what to supply your child as early dinner/pre-show extra snacks on the week of the show.
- Should you wish to offer assistance in the next couple of weeks or on the day with setting up or packing up, please join our Facebook group – *Meltd – a Musical*. We would love your help!
- If you are unsure of your child's costume/outfit, please touch base with their Arts teacher. Pre Primary and Kindergarten are working with their classroom teachers. They will need to have their costume at school the day before the show.
