Dear Parents / Guardians

Next week we recognise Shrove Tuesday, also known as Pancake Tuesday. Shrove comes from the term 'shrive' meaning to 'free yourself from sin'.

Shrove Tuesday falls on the last day before Ash Wednesday, the first day of Lent. Traditionally, Lent is a time of fasting and Shrove Tuesday was the day that any 'indulgent' foods were cleared out of cupboards and used up – foods such as eggs, butter, flour and milk.

To celebrate Shrove Tuesday, students can order banana pancakes for recess. For \$1.00, students will receive one medium pancake.

To be able to enjoy the Shrove Tuesday Pancake order, you will need to pre-order using the Canteen Online ordering system. All orders will need to be placed by 9:00am Friday 24 February.

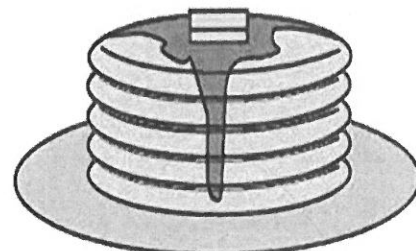
